## REDBOURN ROAD SAFETY UPDATE

Many residents have asked Rosie and Colette what is happening in and around Redbourn Road. The contractors working on the new utilities needed for the Spencers Park Development will be using part of the playing field as a storage and operational site until all of the work is completed. Hertfordshire County Council plan to install a footpath and cycleway from Aldi through to Three Cherry Trees Bridge. A new **Toucan** light controlled pedestrian and cycle crossing will be installed close to the garage. We fought to get this because of the high level of serious accidents many of which resulted in personal injury to drivers, passengers and pedestrians. Traffic islands will also be increased in size so that those crossing the road at various points can do so with more safety. This will help Mums who often struggle to get across safely with their children. Because many new safety features will be put in place the current speed limit of 40mph will stay in place while measurements are carried out to see if they help to reduce speed levels. If this does not work then we will restart the process to get a 30mph limit.

Finally, due to the low level of reported accidents at the T junction of Shenley Road and Redbourn Road it is not possible to progress a safer junction. During a 2 year period we have only had 4 accidents reported to the police. During the same period in the area close to the garage we had 15 accidents, 4 of which were very serious. So priority has been given to the safety measures described above. We will continue to fight for a traffic light controlled T Junction but realistically we will not be able to get the funding until the other safety improvements are in place. If you are involved in an accident at the T junction please notify the police.


