Extensive patching works have recently been completed by the County Council in preparation for the road to be surface dressing in the early part of the new financial year. There were a number of areas which needed patching and when the work is completed it will extend the life of the road.

The County Council is a leader in its highways asset management programme to enable as many roads as possible to be maintained. An extra £7.80m for Hertfordshire roads was announced in the Chancellors budget and this is in addition to the previously allocated funding to maintain our roads.
