CONSIDERED DEVELOPMENT

There continues to be lots of planning applications locally, some small domestic ones which usually go through without a hitch and others which seem to have complete disregard for the locality.

Your Conservative team will always support sustainable sensible development, but we absolutely will not support developments that are disruptive to neighbours and are likely to create even more parking problems than we already have.

Our roads are already gridlocked – we will not sanction developments that make this worse. A case that highlights this is the current planning application to develop the Milbor site in Croxley Road. 21 flats are proposed with just 29 parking spaces.
