It is easy to organise, safer, and more convenient for you. Postal Voting is completely secure and confidential. If you have access to the Internet you can copy this link into your web browser <https://postalvote.conservatives.com> Alternatively take an image of the QR code on the left, or call 01442 228071 and ask for Electoral Services.

Postal Vote Applications must be made before the **15th April**. Your ballot paper will be sent to your home two weeks before the election. Just fill it in and return it immediately. You do not even have to wait for Election Day. You don't need to go to the polling station. You can use your Postal Vote to vote from home at a time that suits you.
